<b>“See and Treat” Procedures</b> (available at the Lichfield Clinic only)	<b>Cost of Procedure</b>
Shave Biopsy – raised mole, skin tags, warty lesions	£350
Scalp Cyst Removal	£390
Cautery – spider naevus, sebaceous gland hyperplasia	£250
Cryotherapy – seborrheic warts, viral warts, flat brown pigmented marks / patches on face and hands	£180
Histology Analysis – Prices start from	£130

All of these procedures are available, at these prices, at the Lichfield Clinic.

The “See and Treat” skin surgery service at the Lichfield Clinic is for the removal of simple benign skin lesions. Most people have the lesion removed on the same day, and the price quoted above includes the consultation fee for that visit. Sometimes, more than one lesion can be removed at the same visit – the cost will depend on the number of lesions, and will be discussed prior to any procedure.

Some surgical procedures may require biopsy and histology. This decision is made on medical grounds and follows National Guidelines. In this situation, the histology fee is in addition to the procedure fee.

Rarely, it may not be possible to remove the skin lesion at the “See and Treat” clinic as it requires more complex surgery than expected or it would be best removed by an alternative method such as laser. In this situation you will be given advice on alternative treatments and only pay the consultation fee.

Excision of suspected skin cancers, and more complex surgery, is usually arranged at one of the local private hospitals.
