

# Stafford Skincare: “See and Treat” Self-Pay Prices

<b>“See and Treat” Procedure Fees</b> (please ring 01543 251807 to arrange an appointment)	<b>Cost of Procedure</b>
Shave Biopsy – raised mole, skin tags, warty lesions	£350
Cyst Removal, Lipoma Removal	£390
Cautery – spider naevus, sebaceous gland hyperplasia	£250
Cryotherapy – seborrheic warts, viral warts, flat brown pigmented marks / patches on face and hands	£180
Excision of a pigmented mole or basal cell skin cancer	£450
Histology Analysis – Prices start from	£130

Sometimes, more than one lesion can be removed at the same visit – the cost will depend on the number of lesions, and will be discussed prior to any procedure.

Some surgical procedures may require biopsy and histology. This decision is made on medical grounds and follows National Guidelines. In this situation, the histology fee is in addition to the procedure fee.

Rarely, it may not be possible to remove the skin lesion at the “See and Treat” clinic as it requires more complex surgery or it would be best removed by an alternative method such as laser. In this situation you will be given advice on alternative treatments and pay a consultation fee only.

All of these procedures can be undertaken, at these prices, at the Lichfield Clinic and at Rowley Hospital, Stafford.

Cryotherapy, Cautery and Shave Biopsy are available at the Cannock Clinic, at these prices, but not cyst removal or excision of skin lesions.

All procedures are available at Spire Little Aston Hospital, but follow Spire Little Aston Hospital’s pricing structure, which is different to the prices listed above.
